#### **CREST Award Project**

This term, Year 11 students took part in the Chelsea Crest Award programme, which was facilitated by Oli from the Chelsea Football Club Foundation. The aim of the project was to encourage students to engage in STEM related learning, by providing them real-life, problem-solving opportunities. The sessions were designed to encourage teamwork, develop autonomy and to allow students to experience what it feels like to be part of a real-life project. The focus centered around creating awareness of a more environmentally friendly school. All students participated extremely well and received a recognised Crest Award Certificate from the British Science Association and Chelsea Football Club.
