A Broad and Balanced Curriculum

Our curriculum at The Flagship School aligns with the National Curriculum but is adapted to meet the needs of each individual child, with close recognition and reference to individual EHCP's. Our core offer of curriculum is delivered through an 8 : 3 ratio of students to staff, small classrooms, structured and balanced lessons which adhere to the needs of each particular student, resulting in a purposeful, safe and unique learning environment for our learners. Our curriculum is carefully designed to prepare our students for their journey into KS4 and our 14 - 16 curriculum of learning, building on their previous knowledge to support them in approaching accredited qualifications.

English and Mathematics

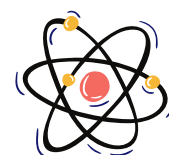

With daily Reading, Writing and Mathematics lessons that are constantly adapted to suit the needs of our students; here at The Flagship School we navigate our learners through English and Mathematics curriculums, building their knowledge and foundations that will support our learners in engaging with KS4 content once they reach our 14 - 16 Curriculum in Year 10 & 11.

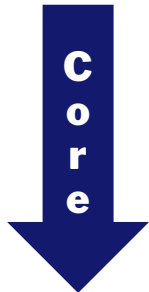
Building the Foundations

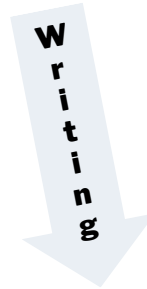

We offer phonics lessons and targeted interventions that focus on developing the five pillars of reading, ensuring students build essential literacy skills.

Science lessons, both theory and practical, are integrated into our curriculum, ensuring that our students have the opportunity to 'bring Science to life' and fully immerse themselves in the world of scientific discovery.

Our Maths curriculum is thoughtfully structured to reinforce prior knowledge while continuously advancing students' understanding of core mathematical concepts. This approach not only strengthens foundational skills but also introduces more complex and specialised areas of the Maths curriculum, fostering a comprehensive and engaging learning experience.
