

23-24 Primary Curriculum Outline

We follow a thematic curriculum based on different topics, such as WWII, The Rainforest, The Wizarding World of Harry Potter, The Earth, Space and beyond.

Our history, geography, art, DT and, at times, science lessons all follow the topic theme to make learning more accessible, make real-life links and fully immerse the children in their learning.

- Our English lessons also link to our topic, often through a relevant book for fiction writing or non-fiction links, such as newspaper report writing, instructions, non-chronological reports about a topic etc.
- We teach reading, SPAG and phonics as separate discrete lessons. All pupils are assessed in terms of phonics on entry.
- Topics (history/geography), science, PSHE, and art/DT are taught weekly. Lessons such as music, MFL, and RE are taught on special days or weeks throughout the year, depending on where they fit into topics or events in the real world.
- PE is taught weekly by Mr Clarke. All pupils go to weekly swimming lessons at the local leisure centre.
- Pupils have weekly cooking lessons. We have gardening in the Spring and Summer months.
