Williamson Class have been visiting the allotments as part of the Wildness Foundation and made apple juice and then enjoyed drinking it together.



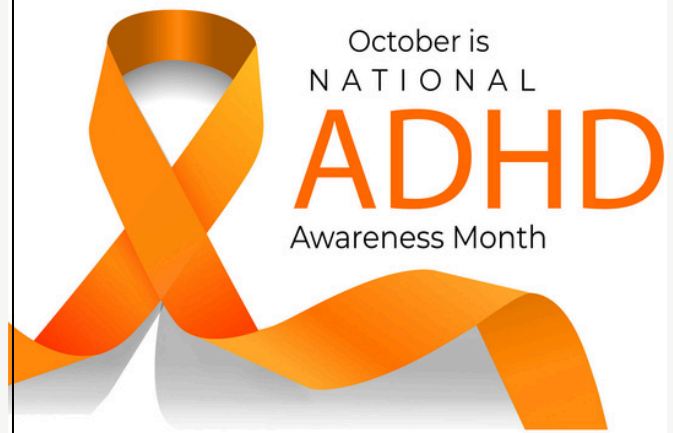
Bronze Class made some fantastic s'mores and enjoyed working outside in the fresh air.
