The Beckmead Express February 2023

The 5th trip of The Beckmead Express took place between the 10th and 13th of February, not so much snow this time but it was definitely still a cold winter in Eastern Europe.



This was an extra trip informed by the fantastic reception we had for the generators we took on trip 4.

We pushed hard to try and raise £20,000 to solely take generators and power packs, in the end thanks to the fantastic generosity of individuals, companies and churches in Burford and Cheam we topped out at just over £22,000 taking us past the £60,000 mark, we have raised overall for this project to date. We took one minibus to the border packed with forty power packs, six generators and $\pounds4,000$ of anti-fever medicine. These goods were all bought at less than cost price through our purchasing agreements.



We unloaded at a familiar warehouse and were helped by new friends from Ukraine.

We heard from our network in Poland and Ukraine that the aid from this trip crossed the border and was distributed in the Donbas region within 48 hours.



The goods we took support civilians who are stranded in this region and spend the majority of the week living underground. Most of these people have literally lost everything and are further trapped by Ukrainians in the West of the country hiking rental prices in an attempt to profiteer.
